Dear Carson Graham Families,

Tl'iknumut, Bienvenue, and Welcome! I hope everyone was able to find some time to connect with nature, and each other, while enjoying our beautiful BC summer. As summer winds down, we are excited to welcome students back for the 2023/24 school year! Our custodial team has done an exceptional job shining up our learning spaces, and our office and counselling teams are welcoming new families this week and finalizing the details for the new school year.

As a large, vibrant school community with almost 1400 students and 125 staff, communication is key! Also new to Carson Graham is Mr. Tuzar Irani who will be our Vice Principal overseeing Grades 10 and 11. We are still in the process of filling staff vacancies and will be updating our website as we fill these positions.

As an extension of last year's school theme *Connections*, this year's school theme will focus on *Relationships* and *Culture*. We will dig deeper into our relationships with ourselves, others and the world around us. With intentionality, we will explore how these relationships contribute to the culture of the entire Carson Graham school community.

Based on student, staff and community feedback during last school year, the 2023-24 timetable at Carson Graham continues to be on a Day 1/Day 2 linear schedule. On Wednesday Sept 6th, Thursday Sept 7th and Friday Sept 8th we are asking students to report to their Period 2 class at 8:55am for a ten-minute Advisory block. Following Advisory, students will report to their scheduled class, commencing at 9:10am. If students have incomplete timetables, they will report to the Counselling Offices for more information on process. Counsellors are prioritizing incomplete timetables first, and course changes will not be considered until Friday Sept 8th.

Carson Graham staff are looking forward to having our grade 8 students embark on building new relationships at our Grade 8 Retreat, happening September 26th. Incoming grade 8 families should already have information regarding this event, but in case they do not, please contact grade 8 administrator, Mr. Dave Cadman (dcadman@sd44.ca). Additional information will also be forthcoming shortly to all families with children in grade 8, including information on our Grade 8 Parent Night scheduled for Tuesday September 12th.
