We hope this letter finds you well. Believe it or not, next Wednesday marks the final day of regular classes! Please be sure to familiarize yourself with the important information below:

### **Locker Clean Out: Monday, June 19th**

We did a short locker clean out today and will do another one on Monday before lunch. We are asking that lockers be cleaned out by end of day on Monday, June 19. Any items left behind will be donated or thrown out. Please leave locker door open with the lock attached and closed to the inside loop as they will be cleaned over the summer. ### **Review and Completion: June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>**
