Hello Carson Families,

This past week at Carson brought memorable events and accomplishments, including One Night Only, Grade 12 Capstone Presentations, and outstanding results across multiple sports.

Our music students delivered a wonderful evening of performances at One Night Only, showcasing the talent of our jazz bands, concert bands, and jazz choir. Grade 12 students completed their Capstone Presentations, sharing thoughtful reflections connecting their experiences, skills, and growth to their post-graduation goals. We also hosted our final Community Initiatives Dinner of the year, welcoming more than 150 guests. Thank you to the students and staff who make this community event possible. Finally, congratulations to our IB Grade 12 students on completing their IB Exams!

In athletics, Carson athletes shone across the province. Nine riders from our mountain biking team competed in Quesnel, with Zoe S and Jonah R earning impressive fourth-place finishes in the Senior Girls and Senior Boys divisions respectively. Our Senior Girls and Senior Boys Rugby teams are currently competing at provincials, following the Junior Boys' strong 10<sup>th</sup> place finish at provincials last week. At the Vancouver Sea to Sky Championships, Carson had one of its best track performances ever, highlighted by Arhsham S's new records in the 800m and 1500m. The golf team finished 2nd in the North Shore Championships and advanced to the Sea to Sky Zone Championships, where they finished in 7th place. The ice hockey team finished in 3rd place in Tier 2 and the badminton and girls' soccer teams finished their season by competing in the North Shore playoffs.

As we enter the final month of the school year, courses are in their final stretch, and many exciting year-end events are on the horizon.
