School based EXAMINATION RULES

READ OUT – verbatim- PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH EXAM

1. Leave any items not authorized for the examination (notes, cell phones, electronic devices, backpacks, books, hats) on the floor at the back of the room. Students are not allowed to have any unauthorized equipment, paper or language dictionaries. **DO NOT BRING VALUABLES - THEFTS HAVE OCCURRED**
2. No food or drinks are permitted.
3. A pencil must be used to complete answer sheets and a pen for all written-response sections.
4. For exams requiring a calculator, students must bring their own, subject to the calculator policy (www.bced.gov.bc.ca/exams/calculators). See your Math teacher for clarification.
5. The exam rules and instructions on the front of the examination booklet will be read aloud immediately before the examination begins. Students must not turn to the next page of the examination booklet until the examination has formally begun
6. Place your name and your teacher's name on the appropriate papers.
7. No students will be permitted to leave the examination room during the first hour of the exam. **DURING THE LAST 15 MINUTES OF THE EXAM, NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE EXAM ROOM.**
8. The order to “stop writing” must be obeyed immediately.
9. The supervisors will not answer questions about the exam content.
10. Students are not permitted to communicate to each other in any way. Should any breach of this regulation be discovered, the Supervisor will confiscate the examination paper immediately.
