Grads should be dropped off on Lonsdale Avenue. There is limited parking for students on P1 of the Education Services Centre. Parents/guardians are not permitted inside the ESC or Gallery due to health restrictions, however they may wait in the gardens outside.

#### 1. Grad Fees

Thank-you to everyone who has paid their grad fees. If you have not had an opportunity to login to your <u>School Cash Online</u> account, we kindly ask that you do so as soon as possible. This fee covers items such as the ceremony filming costs, decorations, rentals, and the grad cap and gown.

## 2. Outstanding Fees

Please check your grad's school cash online account for any outstanding fees from this year or previous years. Fees MUST be cleared prior to the end of June. Thank you for your help with this.

#### 3. Cap, Tassel & Gown

Grads will receive their gown, cap, and tassel soon. Gowns need to be ironed or steamed prior to the ceremony. After the filming, students will leave with their cap and gown, which will be theirs to keep for future photos if they choose.

## 4. Valedictorian

It's time to pick the valedictorian for 2021!

This is the person who will speak on behalf of the graduating class of 2021 at the Grad Ceremony. Grade 12s have already been encouraged to nominate themselves or to encourage their peers to put their name forward.
