Ceremony Dress

Grads are required to wear their gowns to enter the theatre. Only grads wearing gowns will be permitted entry. Caps, gowns and sashes must be worn to cross the stage. Don't forget to fix your tassel to the cap with the 2026 facing out. Please iron your gown and red sash.



Semi-formal dress under your gown is appropriate. People should wear a collared shirt with a tie, dress pants, a dress or a skirt; jackets are unnecessary. Dark dress pants, dark shoes and dark socks are appropriate. Be stylish but practical in your choice of footwear!

Leave all purses, cell phones, gum, and other items with your family and guests. This is a **formal ceremony**, and you will not be permitted to carry anything in your hands.

The Ceremony Program

- Introduction
- Processional: Entrance of the graduates
- Coast Salish anthem, O Canada & Speeches
- Presentation of Graduates, Choir Performance, and Awards Presentations
- Valedictorian & Closing Remarks
- Recessional: Exit of the graduates

This is a formal ceremony and is approximately 3 hours long. We ask that guests stay for the duration of the ceremony. Please hold applause until after each flight of graduates so each graduate's words can be heard by the audience.

Parking

There are multiple pay parking lots within walking distance of the Orpheum.

Theatre Entrance

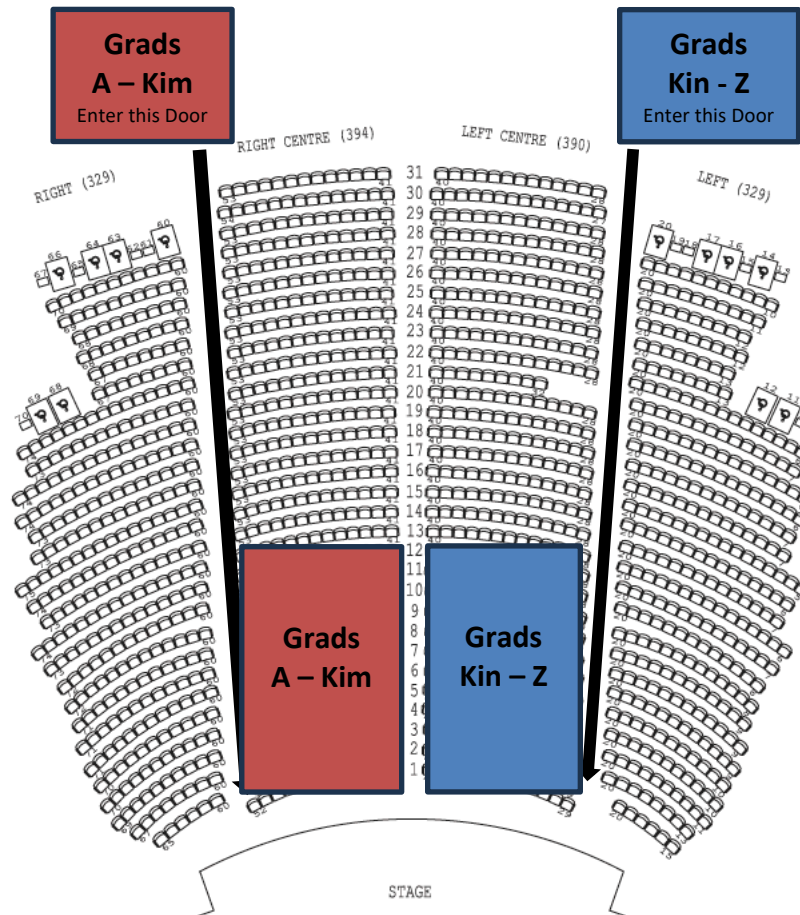
➔ **Graduates** must enter the Orpheum Theatre (601 Smithe St) through the Granville Street Entrance. All grads must be at the theatre **no later than 6:00 p.m.**

➔ **Guests** enter the Orpheum Theatre through the Main Entrance. Lobby doors open at 6:00 pm. Auditorium doors open at 6:30pm. Latecomers will not be seated until there is a break in the program.

Theatre Seating

Seating is general admission. Theatre doors open at 6:30pm. Both the Orchestra and Balcony levels will be open. Graduates will enter through doors 2 and 4 depending on their last name. Please note the location of your graduate on this map.

Grads will be seated in the Right Centre and Left Centre sections from Row 1 to 12.



Ticket Sales

Guests wanting to attend the ceremony must have purchased tickets. A hard copy ticket is required to enter the theatre. If you need to purchase additional tickets, tickets will be available at the Queen Elizabeth Box Office for \$15 each on the day of the event starting at 5:45pm. (Look for Ms. Harman)

Ticket Pick up

Students need to bring a **printed copy or screenshot of their receipt** to the table in front of counselling during lunch on **June 3rd and 4th** to pick up hard copy tickets for the ceremony.
