- **Smoothies:** no protein add-ons. We are continuing the usual flavours and adding a new mango hemp protein smoothie.
- **Well Fed/MLB:** expanded menu, if you would like the quesadilla's or pasta's gluten free please click the gluten free add on.
- **Subway:** Ordering has changed, choose the size of your bun, choose your meat option and choose the gluten free option if desired. Foot long subs are now available. Veggie packs and treat options have been added from Bluhouse.
