### Just a reminder to use Safe Arrival to record your child's absence

1. **SchoolMessenger app.** Use your mobile device to download and install the SchoolMessenger app, available at the Apple App Store, the Google Play Store or [go.schoolmessenger.ca](http://go.schoolmessenger.ca).
