# Just a reminder to use Safe Arrival to record your child's absence

With **Safe Arrival** you will be able to report your child's absence *in advance* using **any of these three options**, which are available to you 24 hours/day, 7 days a week:

1. <u>SchoolMessenger app</u>. Use your mobile device to download and install the SchoolMessenger app, available at the Apple App Store, the Google Play Store or go.schoolmessenger.ca.

If the first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Important: Use an email address that we have on record for you.

Select Attendance, then Report an Absence.

2. <u>SchoolMessenger website</u>. Use the SchoolMessenger website go.schoolmessenger.ca.

### Home for lunch or appointments
