# **Students Leaving the School**

In order for students to leave the school the following procedures must be adhered to:

#### During instructional Hours 8:49-12:00 & 12:55-3:00

- Parents must provide a note to the teacher AND office, outlining the details of the absence

- A call into the absence line would be very much appreciated
- Students sign in or out at the school office

#### **During Lunch hour**

- Must be pre-arranged (phone calls home on the day will not be permitted)

- A parent signed note including where the child will be on that day must be provided to the office

- If two students are planning to leave for lunch together notes are required from both families.

- Students must present the signed parent note and sign-out in the sign-out book at the school office when leaving and sign-in when returning to the school grounds.
- We respectfully request that students do not go to the Cove for lunch
- students must return on time or entered as late
- We will not be allowing students to leave the school unless proper procedures are followed.

# Parents are reminded that the school is not responsible for the safety and behaviour of students once they leave the school grounds.

# **Code of Conduct**

Please review the <u>Code of Conduct</u> with your children prior to the start of school.

#### **Emergency Preparedness**

<u>Safety Week -</u> In order to ensure students know what to do in case of an emergency, staff will carefully explain procedures to students and we will practice these drills in class and during the week of September 20th.

- Monday September 20th fire drill with no alarm, so students are not surprised.
- Tuesday, September 21st earthquake drill (but not the Early Release to parents).
- Wednesday, September 22nd lockdown drill #1- Internal Intruder
- Thursday, Sept. 23rd- Lockdown Drill #2- External Danger
- Friday, Sept. 21st- Shelter in Place risk in the surrounding area one long bell to bring students in to their classroom

# **Comfort Kits**

To enhance our students' safety and well-being, we are expanding our school's efforts to prepare for an emergency this year. Each class has a grab-n-go kit, kept in the classroom and taken by teachers in case the school is evacuated in an emergency or disaster.

In addition to the grab-n-go kits, each class has supplies in case of a lockdown, as well as a separate duffel bag containing **individual comfort kits** for each child and staff member. We need your help to complete these kits.

- 1. Label the zip-lock bag with your child's name.
- 2. Add a family photo. On the back of the photo, please print your child's name, parent's contact phone numbers, care card number and out of area contact person and phone number. List any allergies.
- 3. In addition to the photo, include the following into this bag:
  - chewing gum (optional) sugarless
  - two peanut-free granola or fruit bars, or other non-perishable, high-energy snack
  - two Band-Aids
  - Kleenex
  - small personal item (optional)- for example, cards, toy, letter from parent

Everything must fit into the small ziplock bag, including the solar blanket and poncho supplied by the school. Please return this kit to the classroom teacher no later than Sept. 21st so we may include it in the class carry bag.
