- Please have culturally sensitive costumes as well. We ask that our students follow the Cove Cliff Code of Conduct. We ask that costumes do not create potential tripping or visibility hazards, are manageable without adult support, and can be stored easily in the student's backpack or cubby.
- Each year schools can have a significant amount of garbage (candy and fireworks) on the grounds/field the day after Halloween. If you would like to help us clean up the grounds on the weekend, we'd really appreciate your assistance in making the grounds safe for our children.
- Please remember that we are not allowed to bring in food to share or gifts. We encourage families to take costume photos at home.
