Re: Important Updates from the Superintendent's Office

Thank you to the 1,000+ attendees who joined us for our virtual town hall today. We hope you found the town hall informative. The questions asked were based on emails we had received from our NVSD community of parents and quardians.

We have also taken many of the questions we had received and answered them by adding them to our <u>Back-to-School FAQ</u>. Be sure to bookmark the site, as information is added and updated often.

For those of you who could not attend the town hall, a recording of the event will be posted on our District <u>website</u> shortly.

Further to our <u>welcome back message</u> sent to families on September 8th, 2020, we are pleased to share additional information with you to support a safe and healthy return to school.

Daily Health Check

Families are responsible for assessing their child *daily* for symptoms of the common cold, influenza, COVID-19 or other infectious respiratory disease before sending them to school. **If a child has any symptoms, they must not go to school.** They should stay home and seek care and/or assessment by a healthcare provider. This could include contacting 8-1-1, a primary care provider or nurse practitioner.

To assist you in the daily assessment of your child's health, the North Vancouver School District has posted a <u>Daily Health Checklist</u>, which is based off the <u>BCCDC Health Check</u> (see page 16). The Daily Health Checklist can be printed at home for you to use to assess your child. This is a personal review of the signs and symptoms of COVID-19. It is not necessary to submit this checklist to your child's school.





We are also asking families to complete a one-time acknowledgement of your understanding of your responsibility to do a daily health check of your child(ren). This acknowledgement will be completed through the <u>School Cash Online</u> system, which many of you would have already used to complete school district permission forms online.

You will receive an automated NVSD email notifying you when the acknowledgement form has been added to your School Cash Online account. Instructions on how to create an account on School Cash Online can be found <u>HERE</u>.

Back-to-School Fact Sheet

The Ministry of Education has created a <u>Back-to-School Fact Sheet</u> for families. It answers many common questions around:

- Staying home when sick
- The daily health check
- Learning groups
- Wearing masks at school
- What happens if someone tests positive for COVID-19
