BIKE TO SCHOOL WEEK

Get your bikes tuned, Cove Cliff! Bike to School Week is Monday June 1 to Friday June 5. It is an annual celebration where we encourage students of all ages to bike, roll, or walk to school. Active travel to and from school is associated with positive environmental, social, and safety benefits for people of all ages.

161 schools across Metro Vancouver participated in 2025, with over **25,000 riders** logging over **92,000 active travel trips!**

What it will look like at Cove Cliff for June 1-5:

Students who use active transportation to get to school can **check in at the FRONT of the school every morning starting at 8:20** to log their active trip and enter for a prize draw. There will be one prize given out each day, courtesy of Reckless Bikes Shipyards. Prize winners are announced just before lunch daily.

Families who live farther away can still participate! An idea is to park your vehicle a farther from school than usual and walk in. We hope that this event can be a reason to TRY something different, even just for one day!

SAFETY FIRST!

Here is a **safety checklist** from our RCMP Liaison Officer:

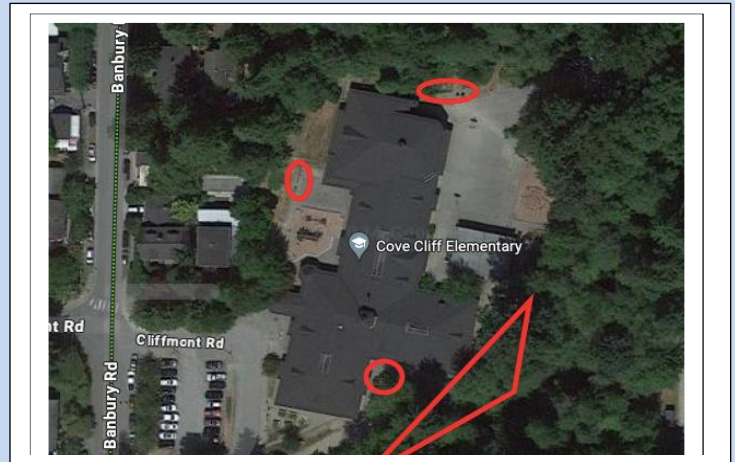
- always wear a helmet (cyclists & scooters)
- cyclists should know the proper hand signals
- WALK bikes and scooters on school grounds
- be aware of surroundings
- wear bright, reflective clothing
- have the proper lighting when darker
- have bells/horns installed on bikes to be audible
- *** Most important is when attempting to cross in front of stopped or slowing vehicles, to make eye contact with the driver **AND** only cross in front when those vehicle wheels have stopped. It is the only way to ensure the vehicle has stopped.

Visual posters have been put up around the school for the students to review these safety points. Please have conversations at home around road safety as well.

Bike Parking

Students are welcome to park their bikes on school grounds during the school day. Bike rack space is limited, but for that week, students are allowed to park their bikes onto the chain-link fences along the creek, as well as behind the music room. Please see map of the school with highlighted areas for locking bikes.

Bikes must be securely locked to the rack or fence (i.e. through the wheel/frame), and no riding is permitted during the school day. We suggest that students also lock their helmet to the bike OR bring it inside to keep in the classroom cubby hooks to ensure that they have it to wear for their return trip home.
