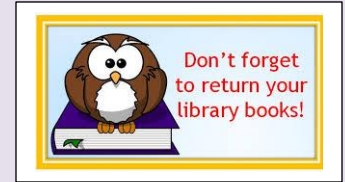
Volunteer / Community Appreciation Event:

LIBRARY BOOK REMINDER

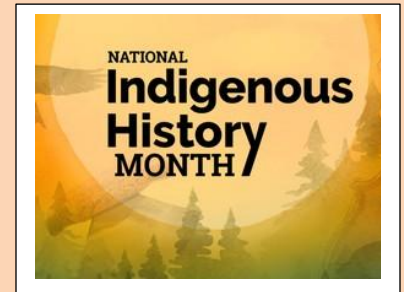
All library books should have been returned to the library by **June 12th**.
