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Dear Parent & Guardians:

We are excited for the return of Track & Field this Spring!

Attached is an event schedule and a practice/coach schedule for all students in Grades 4-7 interested in Track and Field. It is our intention to have as many students participate as possible.

Practice times vary for each event and grade, please refer to the attached schedule for practices held before school, during recess, during lunch and after the school day throughout the week. Students must wear appropriate athletic attire. Students are to first complete the Attached Informed Consent, Risk, Responsibility, and Medical Forms. Forms must be completed and returned to their classroom teacher before students can participate in the program. Students have a paper copy going home today.

At all times, students, coaches and parents will follow our school code of conduct. Secondly, the inclusion/selection of athletes for both the Fun-Meets (all participants) and the Qualifying Meets (selection) will be based on the consistent attendance and output at weekly practices. Both practices and qualification meets will run "rain or shine" to ensure the timeline aligns with the Swangard Event.

Each student who completes the package and participates will attend the "Fun" track meet at Windsor Secondary on May 4th, 2022 from approximately noon until 4:30 pm. Students who do not attend the practice sessions (more than 2) will not be eligible for qualifications.

Further information will come through the month as the complexity of Track and Field requires more frequent communication than normal. We will also load updates and additional information onto our Website.
