Attn: All students with a Period 2 Study Block this Semester:

Earlier this semester, all Handsworth students worked through a Goal Setting and Core Competency reflection in Period 2, specifically focusing on **THINKING**. Part ONE should be complete by now and Part TWO must be completed before January 26<sup>th</sup>.

Please make sure you check in with Mr. Forsyth in the Library to complete Part Two (Reflection). When done, take a picture of your reflection so that you have a digital file to save, and take home the work so that you can discuss the process and how you did with your personal goal this semester.

A note that this activity is mandatory as part of the Ministry's Reporting Order.

#### Done:

- Students complete PART ONE: START Understand My Goals and Create and Action Plan
  - Students have the flexibility to set goals that can be broad or specific, with the primary emphasis on their THINKING within a course they are taking - or more generally about a thinking goal across all courses. Examples are provided for each prompt to help students set their goals and create their action plan.
  - o Mr. Forsyth will keep the goal setting and reflection page for students and will return the document to you at the end of the semester for the reflection phase.

## To Do:

- Students complete PART TWO: END Self-Reflection.
  - o Students will assess their progress toward their goals and share their insights from the process. This should be done prior to the end of Semester 1 (January 26th).

Again, once you have completed the Self-Reflection, please take a picture of it for your digital file and then take your document home and can share your growth, learning, and competency development with your family. Parents and/or guardian contact have been included on this email so that they are aware of this process for our Period 2 study block students.
