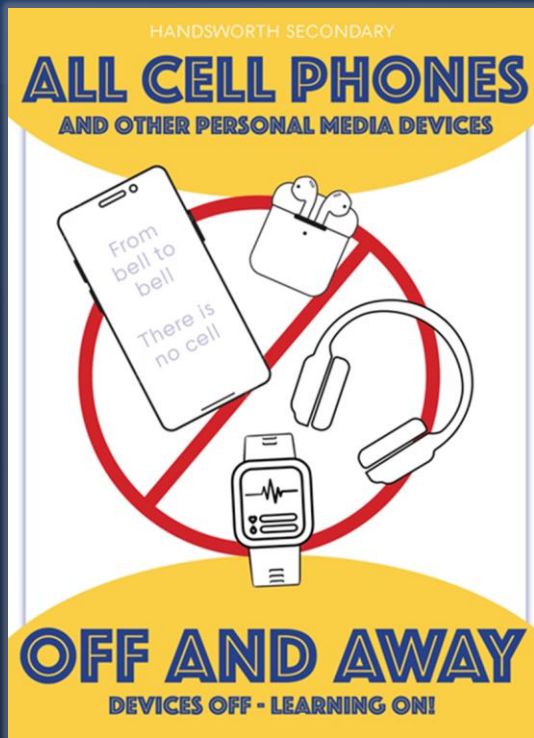

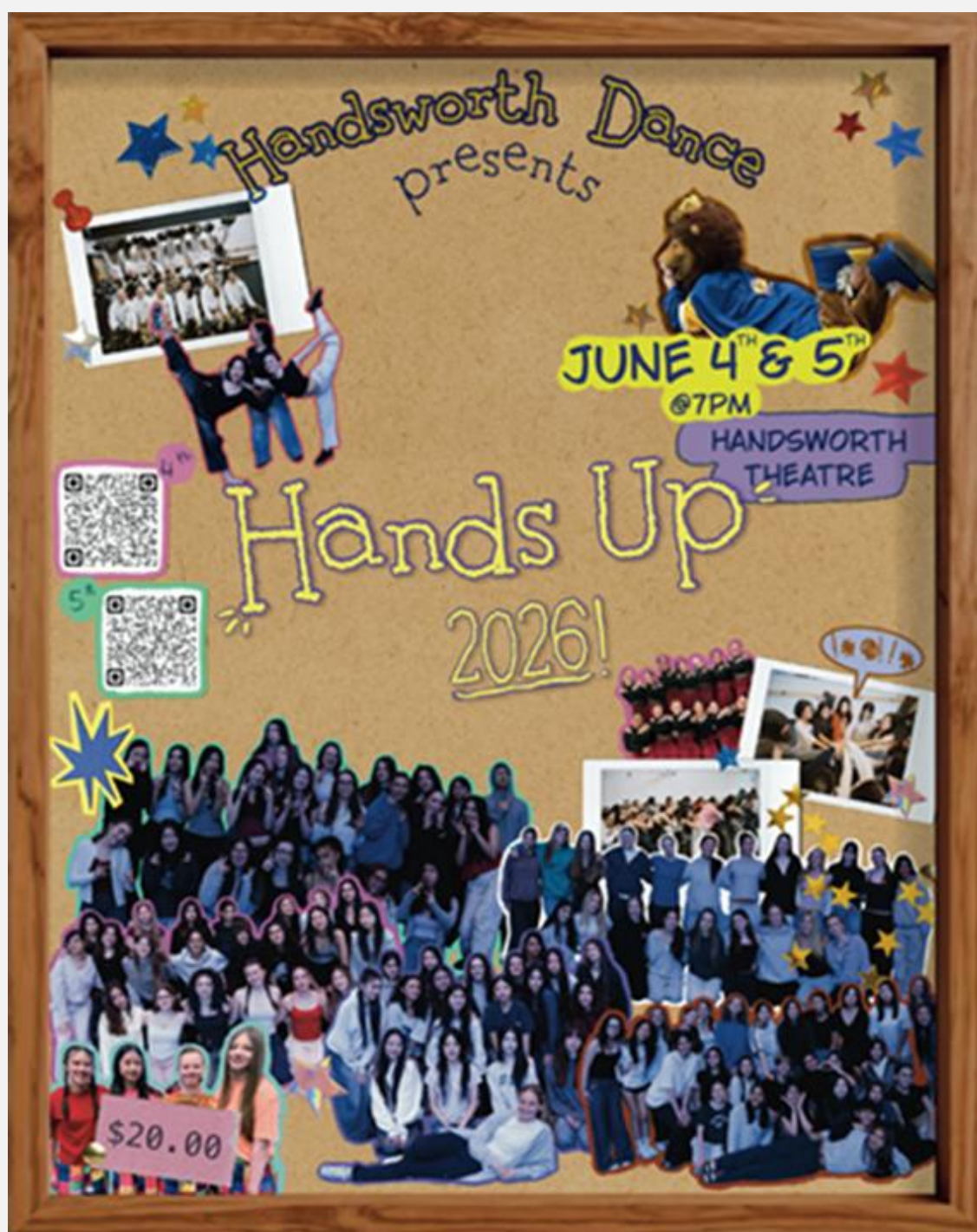

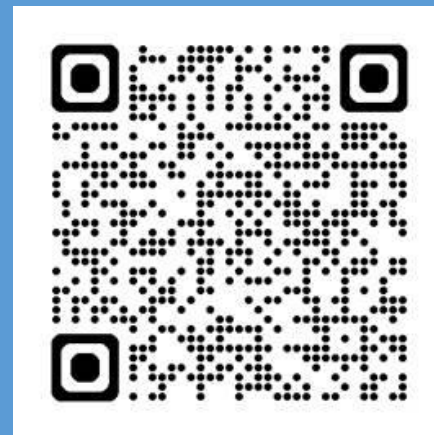

- Thank you to all players for an amazing season!

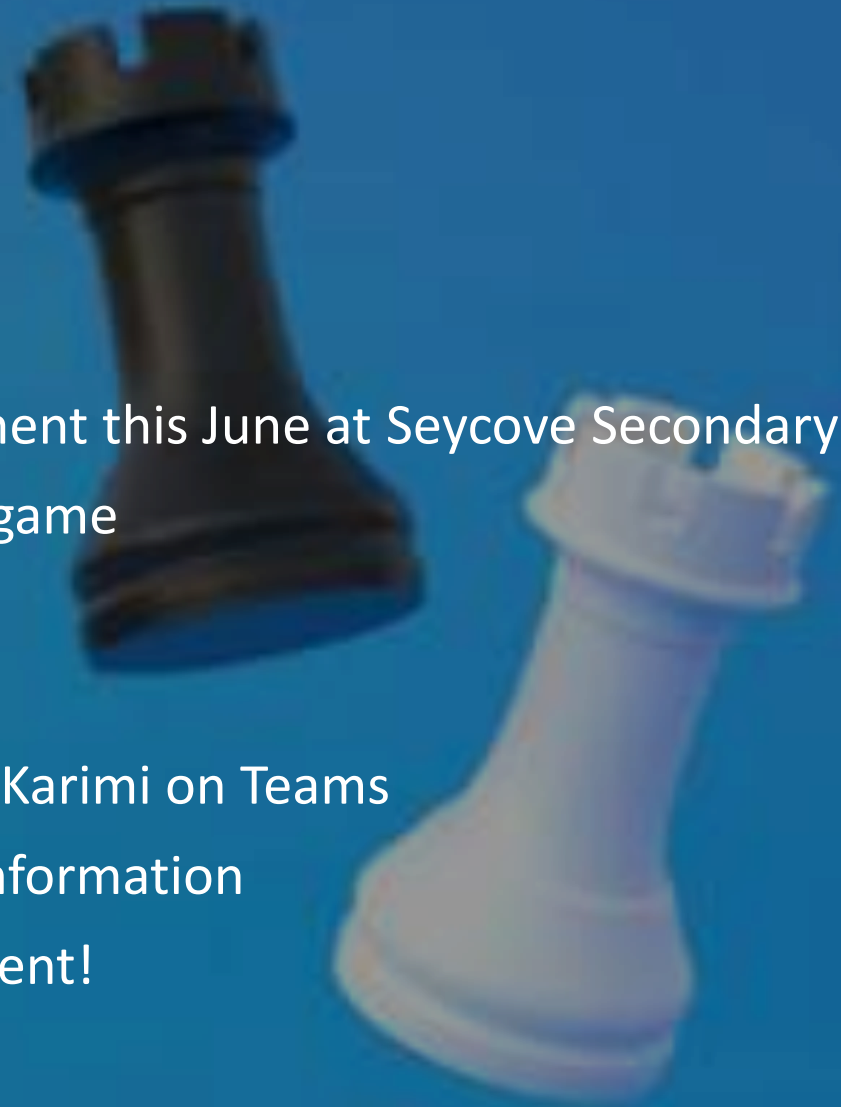


# Grade 11 Students Planning on Work Experience
