Attendance Reporting Procedures





FORMAT when reporting an absence:

- First name of student
- Last name of student
- ✓ Grade
- → Date of absence (whole day or state the portion of the day)
- ✓ Explanation for absence ("excused", "ill", "appointment", "vacation")
- Your name & relation to the student. (Only emails from parents and legal guardians are accepted.)



Provincial Assessment Postponement

Due to the impact of the recent BCGEU strike action on the provincial assessment technical service provider, the Graduation Literacy Assessment Sessions originally scheduled for November 3rd - 4th have been postponed.

The Ministry has confirmed that early admission to post-secondary institutions in BC will not be impacted by the change.



Boys Club Network

December has already been a busy month. The Boys Club welcomed two inspiring guest speakers. Superintendent Peri Mainwaring, a former Handsworth student and now Officer in Charge of the North Vancouver detachment, spoke about her experiences as a police officer. Along with discussing her personal journey, Peri highlighted the importance of community policing and how law enforcement can take an educational approach to building trust and safety.



The Club also heard from former student Robert Maingot, who shared his journey growing up in North Vancouver. He spoke openly about his involvement in soccer, martial arts, bodybuilding, and performing in a rock band, offering a heartfelt perspective on resilience and vulnerability.



In addition, the Boys Club ran a fundraising campaign for "Movember" to support male health awareness, including mental health and cancer research. Their efforts raised \$406.80 for the Canadian Cancer Society, making November a month of inspiration and impact.
