




WEX News—Student Spotlight


NVSD invites students and their families to explore various trade opportunities available to students in Grade 10-12.

Using Gaming Grant funds, many students that played football this fall had a new SpeedFlex helmet. Consistency ranked five stars in studies for safety and wearability. As noted by the Handsworth equipment manager, the SpeedFlex helmets were highly rated among Handsworth players as well. A varsity player noted "Honestly, the SpeedFlex is just next-level. It's super comfortable, and you feel so protected out there. It's the helmet everyone wants. Can't im-

agine playing without it." The PAC hopes to continue to support the football program and provide additional SpeedFlex helmets to prioritize student safety.
