The Handsworth Artificial Field It is firmly budgeted in the District of North Vancouver's plan and will be going to tender.

The proposed start date is the end of summer 2025 with a one year build time and an expected opening date of September 2026.

The field will include practice lines for football, rugby, soccer, field hockey, with nets and football uprights. Bleachers will be installed on the building side of the field. There will be a place marker for a track but completion would need to be privately funded
