

The Role of a Counsellor



- Provide confidential counselling
- Share coping strategies to deal with mental health challenges
- Help students solve problems with peers and/or family
- Help students feel safe and connected at school
- Support students to talk to teachers and advocate for their needs in class
- Provide students with post-secondary guidance



Problem-Solving: Who to Talk to

Contact Classroom Teacher

-Ask questions, articulate concerns, seek clarification


