
## Grade 8 Elective Option

### **Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirement**



- New for students graduating in 2024 and beyond
- Opportunity to honour our responsibility for and commitment to Truth, Reconciliation, and Anti-Racism
- A fantastic way to indigenize our curricula
- Minimum one four-credit course with an Indigenous focus
- Embedded within current 80-credit graduation requirements
- How to fulfil this requirement, effective 2023-24:
  - English First Peoples 11: Literary Studies & Writing 11 (+ English 11 credit)
  - English First Peoples 12 (+ English 12 credit)
  - English First Peoples 12 Theatre Production (+ English 12 credit)
  - BC First Peoples 12 (+ Social Studies 11 or 12 credit)

## Courses and programs to support students

### Peak Performance

- 1. Designed for elite-level student athletes and performers with a C+ average or higher & training 15hrs/week or more in one area.
- 2. Students are able to request time out of their timetable to attend their training commitments and/or work on school work at home. Students typically remove Physical and Health Education 8 or an elective course from their timetable.
