Dear Handsworth Families of 2024 Graduates:

As we embark on the final term of the school year, I am certain the realization that we are down to the final couple of months of the school year – and the final lap of your journey through K-12 – is sinking in. This time of year is especially important for our Grade 12s, not only to prepare for the next chapter in life, but also to celebrate all of the accomplishments that have led to where you are now. With that, I am very pleased to share with you the details of our upcoming grad events.

Graduation Ceremony Rehearsal

Wednesday, June 5th, 7:30am in the Handsworth Grand Commons. To prepare for the ceremony, graduates are required to attend a rehearsal scheduled for the morning of Wednesday, June 5th. As part of the morning event, a Grad Breakfast will also be hosted by the Grad Parent Committee. Graduates, please be at the school by 7:30am for breakfast, followed by a rehearsal that will end at 9:10am. Staff will distribute Grad gowns (with stole and cap) during this event. Gowns have been custom ordered for each student and are theirs to keep. To avoid a delay in receiving grad gown, please ensure that your School Cash Online payments are up to date.

Graduation Ceremony

Monday, June 10th, 7:00pm at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre: 630 Hamilton Street, Vancouver.

<u>Grads are asked to please arrive at Queen E by 6:15pm.</u> Each student's grad gown will serve as their entry ticket. All others attending the ceremony will need to purchase tickets for the ceremony in advance using School Cash Online. Tickets are \$10 each and will not be available to purchase at the door. There are no limits on the number of tickets that you wish to purchase, and reserved seating is not available.

Grade 12 Valedictorian Applications

Grade 12s interested in applying to be this year's valedictorian can access the application form on the **MS Teams Grad 2024 Team page**. Completed applications are due by **Friday, April 26**th **at 3:00pm** and should be handed in directly to Mr. Hungle. We will contact those students who meet the criteria and have completed a thorough and thoughtful application to audition in front of a committee of staff and students.

Graduation Banquet

<u>Friday, June 14th, 6:00pm – 11:00pm at the Westin Bayshore Hotel: 1601 Bayshore Drive, Vancouver.</u> This event is for grads and is open to their family and guests. Tickets are \$150 each and can be purchased through School Cash Online. Please note that this is a dry event for all guests (grads, parents and guests). There is no alcohol permitted prior to arrival or during this event and there are no in and out privileges or refunds for those not granted entry or asked to leave due to alcohol or substance use. As a school event, all Handsworth *Code of Conduct* expectations apply.

Ticket sales are open beginning on Monday, April 15, 2024 through Friday, May 10, 2024. Banquet table arrangements are organized by Ms. Frith, here is the step by step process:

- 1. Families purchase tickets (Cash Online). There is no limit as to many tickets each family purchases.
- 2. Graduates and family members decide who they will sit with:
 - a) Tables seat 8, 9, 10 guests. We can squeeze 11 people at a table that normally seats 10 people.
 - b) There are only 10 tables that seat 12 guests. If this is what your family wants, please make sure you have a back up option should the tables be occupied before your graduate signs up.
- 3. The graduate will then fill out a form with each person's first and last name sitting at their table. (form attached)
 - a) Graduates sometimes choose to sit with their friends and their parents sit at a table nearby.
 - b) It is the graduate's responsibility to fill out a form that includes the adults that are with them.
- 4. Graduates and family members choose their top 5 choices for where they would like to sit in the banquet room.
