

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Academic Advising: Your advisor is the person who knows you by name and understands your goals. Talk to them about program planning, degree requirements, or questions about your academics.

Centre for Accessibility: The Centre for Accessibility facilitates disability-related accommodations and programming initiatives designed to remove barriers for students with disabilities and ongoing medical conditions in all aspects of university life.

Student Resource Centre: Connecting you with tutoring, study guides, course assessments and more, the Student Resource Centre will give you a boost and confidence in your courses.



CAMPUS LIFE

Student Life Office: The extracurricular activities that take place outside of the classroom are what make life fun, interesting, and memorable. Add to your university experience by taking part in events, service learning, experiential learning, and student government.

Centre for Career Development: Build your personal profile, beef up your resume, and make new connections. The Career Centre provides opportunities that allow you to expand your network and gain real-world, on-the-job experience.

Campus Ministry: Annual College programming animates the faith life of Catholic students, staff, and faculty. You can also connect with the UBC Chaplains, which provide spiritual care for student of many faiths including Buddhist, Muslim, Jewish, Bahá'í, Anglican, Baptist, Brethren Tradition, Pentecostal, Presbyterian, and United Churches.

HEALTH AND WELLNESS

Counselling: Through the UBC Counselling Services, you will find support in managing your mental health, including same-day counselling.

Health Services: Visit a doctor, nurse or other medical professional, virtually or in-person, through the UBC Student Health Centre.

On-campus exercise facilities: The UBC Aquatic Centre, campus fitness centre and Student Recreation centre offer drop-in fitness, group fitness classes and intramural leagues. Pop into an afternoon yoga class or swim some laps to refresh your mind.

At Corpus Christi-St. Mark's, we focus on you as an individual.

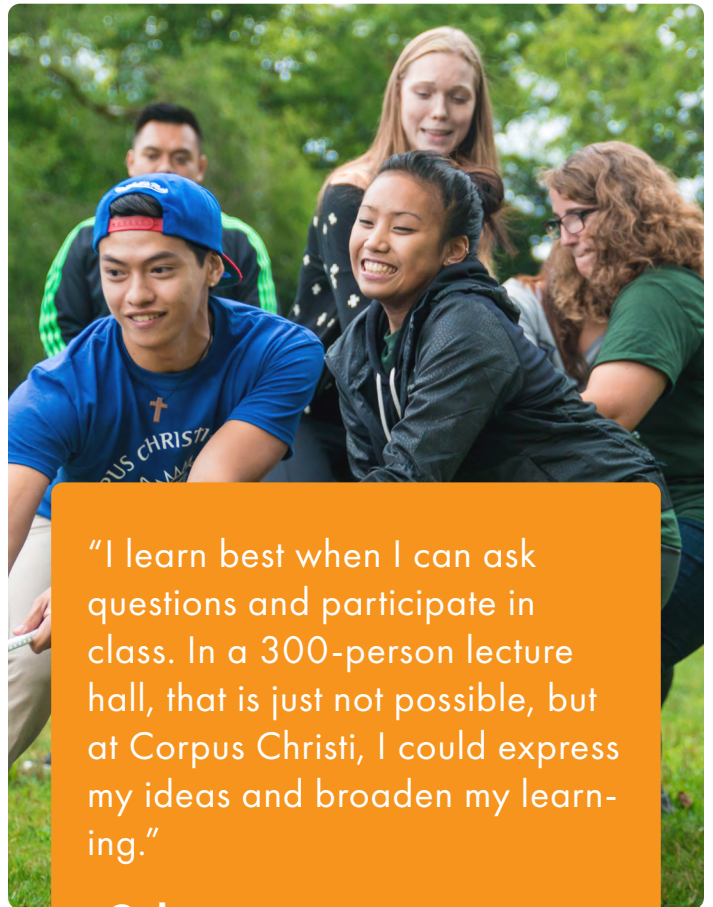

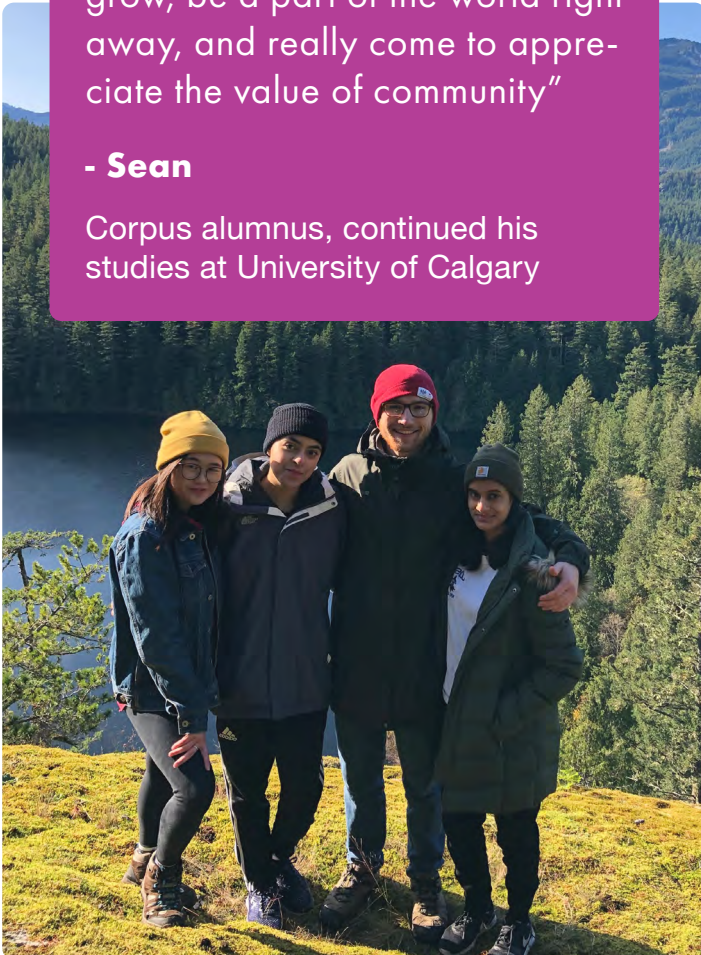
