

## **Instructions for Students:**

- 1. Students are asked to report in person to the Exam Room <u>at least 30 minutes before the start</u> of each exam for a prompt start. Extra time will not be possible for late arrivals.
- 2. Do not bring unnecessary items into the venue to avoid delays.
