ATTN: ALL Grade 10 Students and Parents/Guardians:

The BC Graduation Program requires ALL students graduating in BC to write the following Graduation Assessments in order to meet grad requirements:

- Grade 10 Graduation Numeracy Assessment
- Grade 10 Graduation Literacy Assessment
- Grade 12 Graduation Literacy Assessment

This year, all Handsworth grade 10 students will be required to write their Graduation Numeracy 10 (June) and Graduation Literacy 10 (January) Assessments.

Grade 10s are scheduled to write the **Grade 10 Literacy Assessment** during the assessment period of **January 23rd – January 25th**. This letter is going out now to give lots of notice to students and families to ensure that students are able to plan for and be available for their scheduled assessment. Classroom teachers are aware that students will be missing classes during this week of assessments. As mentioned, the Grade 10 Graduation Literacy Assessment is a grad requirement for all students graduating in British Columbia. All grade 10s **MUST** write the assessment during their scheduled session in January.

Please review the schedule below closely so that you are aware of when and where students are scheduled to write – and please have students put the date and time in their calendars! Students have been divided according to (legal) last name.
