The Salmon Tank



When the egg is ready to hatch, baby salmon break free of the egg's soft shell retaining the yolk as a nutrient-rich sac that hangs below its body. (The orange pouches hanging beneath) At this stage they are called Alevin and are about 2.5 cm in length. During the next month students will observe the Alevin hiding in the gravel nest, feeding from the yolk sac until it is completely absorbed. The yolk sac contains protein, sugar minerals and vitamins.
