- 1:30-2:30 and 6:00-7:00



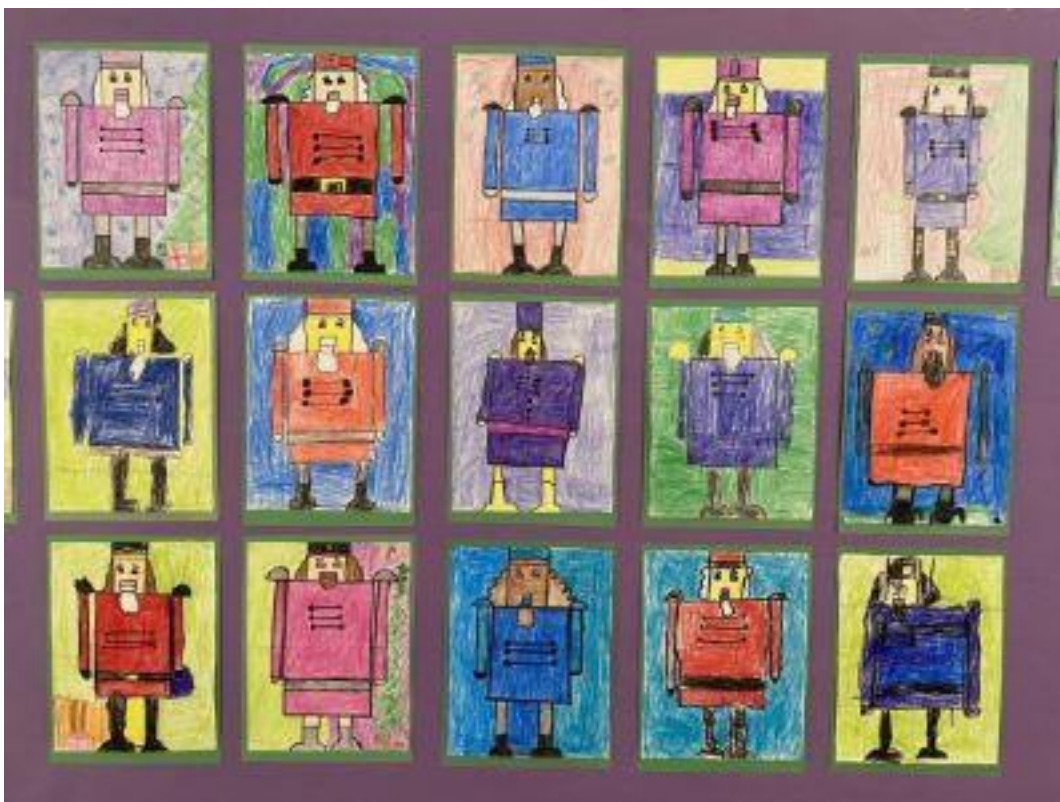
- 2. Winter weather** - Please make sure your children are dressing for the cold, and often wet, weather.
