# **Important Information:**

Traffic Safety: Please help us keep everyone safe by following all posted traffic rules around Larson. Traffic congestion before and after school continues to be a concern, and we ask for your patience and cooperation. If issues arise, please respond with kindnessespecially in front of children. A calm and respectful approach helps ensure the safety and well-being of all our students and families.



Student Absence and Late Arrival Procedures: If your child will be absent, please notify the school using the Safe Arrival Program through School Messenger. This app allows you to quickly and easily report your child's absence. We encourage all families to use the app. If you experience any issues, you can call 604-903-3570 and leave a message with your child's name, teacher, division number, and reason for absence. If your child arrives late, they must check in at the office to sign in. This is a safety requirement, and there are no exceptions.

Students Leaving Early: If a student needs to leave school during the day, they must be signed out at the office by a parent or guardian. For Grade 7 students only, self-sign-out is permitted with written parental consent provided to the office in advance. When picking up your child, please go directly to the office. Students will be called from their classroom to meet you there.

Personal Digital Devices (PDD): Students are expected to leave personal digital devices (cell phones, tablets, etc.) at home or in their bag/backpack when at school. PDD use is not permitted at school. This includes the use of smart watches. They may be worn and used to tell time only. They are not to be used to play games or communicate with anyone. Should an urgent situation arise and you need to contact your child, please call the main office. Students are not able to answer calls or texts during the school day. We will contact you if there is an emergency with your child.

Consent Forms: This year, there are three forms that need to be completed through School Cash Online. In addition, a paper package was sent home with your child that also requires your attention. Please return the completed paper forms to your child's classroom teacher as soon as possible. All forms must be submitted by September 19. 


