### **Important Information:**

## BIKES & SCOOTERS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS:

Wheels at School – Safety First! Students may ride bikes, scooters, skateboards, or in-line skates to and from school. No matter the wheels, helmets must be worn and safe, respectful behaviour is expected.

## Important Reminders:

Riding is not allowed on school grounds. Please walk your wheels once you arrive.

Bikes should be locked at the courtyard racks. Scooters, skateboards, and skates must be stored safely in classroom cloakrooms to prevent tripping hazards. If a student struggles to follow these expectations, they may be asked to leave their wheels at home.

## E-SCOOTERS:

In British Columbia, **you must be at least 16 years old** to legally ride an electric kick scooter. This rule is part of the province's pilot program for e-scooters and applies across all participating municipalities. Even with adult supervision, children under 16 are **not permitted** to operate e-scooters.
