#### **HEAD LICE PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS AND FAMILIES**

Head lice are common in schools but do **not** spread disease and are **not** a public health risk. Our focus is on managing lice effectively while minimizing disruption and stigma.

#### What to Do:

- Learn more about head lice <u>click here</u>
- Check your child's hair regularly in a well-lit area using conditioner and a fine-toothed comb. Pay close attention to the scalp, behind the ears, and the nape of the neck.
- If you find lice, check all household members and treat only those affected using one of the recommended methods (shampoo/rinse, wet combing, or spray).
- Notify the school if your child has head lice.
- Recheck after a few days—lice can be missed the first time.
