



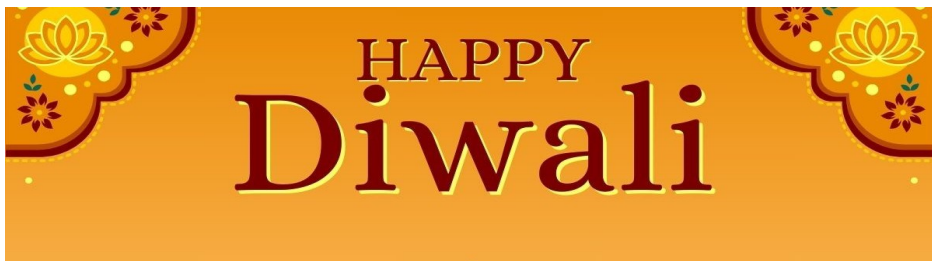

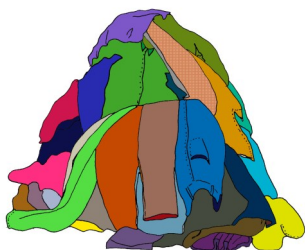

### LOST & FOUND

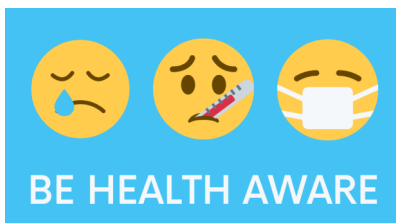
