- Costumes must be culturally respectful
- Costumes must be SOGI appropriate (inclusive of all sexual orientations and gender identities)

Note: Students not following the above guidelines may be asked to change or adjust their costumes. Help us avoid clothing/face paint changes and disappointed students—thanks for your support!
