The Lynn timer market was started over 20 years ago to give ALL students an opportunity to think of others and give gifts to their families.

The market builds community through generosity. Families share their wealth by donating "new or almost new" items that others may enjoy for a time.

Students make a gift list for up to three (3) family members to shop for.

The items are set up in the gym on decorative tables with special "elves" (parent volunteers) to help choose and purchase gifts.



All items are flexibly priced between \$1.00 and \$5.00 for students during the day.

**The Gr. 6/7 classes will also be selling homemade items for charity as part of the market.*

Classes visit the market one at a time. Students shop with donation money they bring to school just for the market. **All proceeds from the market go back to the school.*



**The market, along with a 50/50 draw and raffle, will open AFTER SCHOOL for families, staff, students and community from 2:45pm to 4:30pm.*

There will be cash and credit payment options after school.
