What you should expect regarding your child's report card

Report cards will be posted for families on Dec 11th. We would like everyone to be sure to **remember** that our students had a <u>big disruption</u> in their schooling (last spring) which has impacted some of the learning during this first term. Teachers have been working to catch students up and get them to where we typically would see them. We still have some work to do in this area. All students are experiencing school in a new way this year and this will likely have an impact on the first term report cards. We also recognize that school has been disrupted for some learners as they have missed days due to isolation needs for the family.

Please do not be alarmed if you see marks that you wouldn't have anticipated for your child. We encourage you to <u>pay the most attention to the comments</u>. Those will give you the best indication of how your child is doing, where they are at and what they need to work on. First term report cards are simply a SNAPSHOT of where your child is at right now and will not negatively impact any final reporting that is recorded on their permanent record.
