#### Steps to booking:

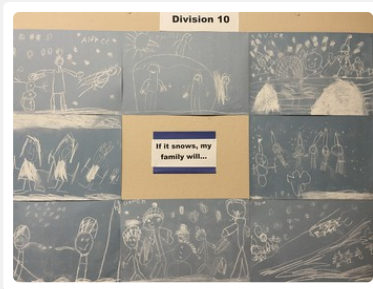
- Use the link above

## Valentines Day Celebrations - Please be aware!!

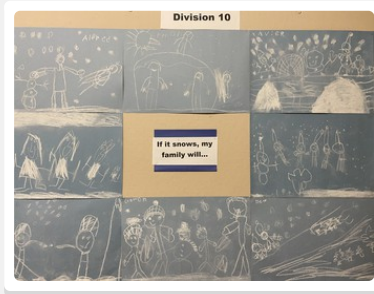
IMPORTANT: Valentine's Day message for families
