### IMPORTANT: Connecting with your class teachers

Please remember, if your child is staying home because you have been asked to isolate, you are nervous about safety, or for another reason, we are here to help.

Learning is continuing in the classrooms. Children who are staying home, will need to connect with their class teacher to keep up with the work. This connection is very important.

Last spring, the Ministry of Education stated that student grades would not "drop" because of the pandemic. This fall, the expectation is that learning continues and students are engaging, learning and completing assignments whether they have chosen to be home or in class.

We know that students do better at school with their learning, social engagement, and overall mental health. Please don't hesitate to reach out to your class teacher or the school to find out what we can do to help your child feel safe and to be here at school.

#### Student Masks and Health/Safety reminders

With the announcement that masks are mandatory in public indoor and retail settings we did want to provide a clarification for families. While this update doesn't currently involve a mandatory order for schools, as always, students are welcomed and encouraged to wear a mask at school if they would like.



We do have many families (including staff) that have family members that are incredibly vulnerable should they contract COVID. With our recent exposures, we have noticed an increased number of students wearing masks at school to keep themselves and their families safe. We want you to know that your child is welcome to do this and that the staff also appreciate the support.

As a reminder, at Lynnmour/Xa7elcha, we <u>do not</u> have have the benefit of separating students by individual desks. We do have students spread out as much, but they do sit at tables with classmates. Students stick within their same cohort and teachers do their best to maintain a seating arrangement within their classroom. Students regularly wash and sanitize their hands and refrain from sharing common items.
