National Aboriginal Veterans Day - Nov 8th

In 1994, the first Aboriginal Veteran's Day was recognized in Winnipeg to honour First Nations, Métis and Inuit soldiers who served in wars for Canada. Before that, Indigenous Veterans were not permitted to participate in Remembrance Day Ceremonies and were not invited to lay wreaths at cenotaphs. November 8th is now recognized Nationally as Aboriginal Veteran's Day.
