#### 1. Treasurer update:

- Vicki reconciled financial statements to end of November and funds are looking good
- Fun lunches have already raised \$2300, which is getting close to our goal of \$3000!
- Holiday market raised \$1953 so far and there are a few silent auction items still available so potential to raise another \$200-300
- Donations option is functioning through Zeffy and Zeffy is now connected to the PAC bank accounts so that the proceeds from the winter market can be transferred
- Net revenue so far this year is \$6700, so we are on track to reach our goal for the year
- Minimal expenses so far, other than grade 7 hoodies and a few classroom supplies, which will show on the (end of) December statement
- School received a large grant, which is reducing the expenses that school staff would otherwise submit to the PAC
- No update regarding the outdoor learning space as quotes received have been very high but Vicki will connect with Glenda regarding a contact who could assist with pricing
- Feedback received that companies that have a budget for community grants take requests earlier in the year so this should be considered next year

#### 2. Winter Market report

• Winter market went very well, with good attendance and community engagement; kudos to the volunteers who worked hard to organize it all!
