1. Treasurer's Report (Pablo)

## Operating Account

- -Currently close to \$14,000 meaning we need to raise a little over \$4200 additional funds this year to achieve our proposed budget. A bit more would be preferable of course.
- -Glenda reminded new parents how the PAC funds have helped support school needs in various ways over the years

### **Gaming Account**

-Approximately \$4000 in the account. These are very restricted funds and is not a lot of money based on number of students/classes we want to support.

We have managed with the funds we have raised in the past few years because covid restrictions limited the number of events/field trips etc that the school has undertaken during those years. This year things are more accessible and more funds are needed than previous years, which will require more from the PAC.
