Red Dress Day - Friday May 5th

Red Dress Day marks the National Day of Awareness for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, and Two-Spirited people in Canada. At Queen Mary teachers will bring recognition to this day in ways suitable to the age of the students.

This day of awareness honours Indigenous women, girls and two-spirit people who have been subject to disproportionate violence in Canada. Red Dress Day was inspired by Métis artist Jaime Black's *REDress Project* installation.

We encourage students to wear red to school on May 5th, taking part in the nation-wide recognition of this important day.
