As we launch into the final school term, please be reminded of the following school procedures and expectations:

Signing children out during the school day (e.g., appointments etc.)

PLEASE be reminded of the following procedures when taking your child out of school during the school day:

- Come into the school to the office
- Sign your child out
- The office staff will contact the teacher to have your child sent to the office
- Wait at the office for your child to meet you

This is for safety reasons – please adhere to these procedures.

PLEASE do not go directly to the classroom door to get your child – this is disruptive to the learning environment.

When entering the school day <u>at any time during the instructional day or during the noon hour/recess</u> breaks, PLEASE proceed directly to the school office (even if simply dropping off something for your child). This is for safety and security reasons, and to minimize disruptions.

Student Cell Phones/Apple Watches

Students are not to use personal cell phones during the school day unless a staff member gives them permission to do so. Cell phones must be kept on silent mode. Parents should contact the school directly if they need reach their children instead of sending messages via cell phones/Apple watches.
