We hope you all enjoyed the four-day weekend – this "short" week has been action packed!

Highlights from this week at Queen Mary:

On Tuesday, staff and students acknowledged **International Mother Language Day**, celebrating our multilingual community. Stories were read and shared in languages other than English, and classroom walls and doors became decorated with greetings in the languages spoken by children of the class. Below, a Grade 2 student added their Japanese version of The Three Little Pigs to the classroom library, and Kindergarten students drew pictures of themselves and printed greetings in their Mother Languages.





On **Pink Shirt Day** student leaders from the QM Social Diversity Club visited classes to read stories aloud. The stories read had themes connecting to being kind, inclusive, and respectful of differences, while raising awareness of how to be an "upstander" and stand up against bullying. A noon-hour dance party, held in the gym, was enjoyed by students of all ages.
