Every year Queen Mary staff and students take part in the Jump Rope for Heart Fundraiser, for the Heart and Stroke Foundation, to raise awareness of the importance of making healthy choices when young to reduce risk of heart disease and stroke in later years, AND to raise funds for the **Heart and Stroke Foundation** so they can continue the work they do to help Canadians.
