IMPORTANT QM INFORMATION

In the spirit of being a Community School, Queen Mary endeavours to "give back" to our community, providing supports where needed throughout the year. During the holiday season our elves are very busy with this endeavour in mind! Thank you for all the contributions toward the food drive that took place this week. On Monday, December 1st we will start to collect donations for the **Giving Tree** and the **Holiday Market**.

Holiday Market Donations:

RCMP Reminder – Please make sure children are well aware of these E-Scooter rules and violation fines.

As part of our commitment to student safety and community awareness, we are partnering with the RCMP Youth Support Team in promoting safe and responsible e-scooter use. E-scooters are becoming increasingly popular, and it's important that families understand the rules and safety requirements that apply.

Key Safety Guidelines:

- Riders must be **16 years or older** to operate an e-scooter in British Columbia.
- Helmets are mandatory for all riders.
- E-scooters should only be used in designated cycling lanes, not on sidewalks.
- Lights and a bell are required for visibility and safety.
- Only one rider per scooter is permitted.

Violations can result in fines, and more importantly, unsafe riding can lead to serious injuries. Please take time to speak with your children about these rules and encourage responsible riding habits.
