May 5th: Red Dress Day

Red Dress Day marks the National Day of Awareness for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women, Girls, and Two-Spirited people in Canada. This day of awareness honours Indigenous women, girls and two-spirit people who have been subject to disproportionate violence in Canada. Red Dress Day was inspired by Métis artist Jaime Black's *REDress Project* installation.

As May 5th falls on a Sunday this year, we will acknowledge this day at Queen Mary on Monday May 6th by encouraging students to wear red to school. Queen Mary teachers will inform and bring awareness to students in a respectful and sensitive manner in ways suitable for the age of the students.
