Tips for Your Child's Success at School

<u>Social-emotional learning (SEL) and mental well-being</u> are important components of student growth and success.

At Ridgeway, we value working in partnership with families to ensure children develop strong SEL skills and mental well-being strategies.

Student success at school is greatly influenced by how they are feeling on any given day. Students function better, think more clearly, and show more resiliency at school if they have the following daily supports in place at home:

- Talk enthusiastically to your child about the new school year, reminding them of the fun they will have with their friends, even if they are not in the same class.
- Engage in physical activity everyday.
- Get 9 hours of sleep a day and reduced screen exposure for a minimum of 90 minutes prior to bedtime.
- Eat a healthy breakfast that includes protein.
- A healthy lunch for school that includes protein, veggies/fruit, and limited sugar.
 Please avoid "junk food" and send a water bottle daily.
- Support to get in the habit of packing their school bag and choosing their clothing the night before to help the morning begin calmly.

What if my child is absent?

It is very important we know where students are and appreciate your support with this important matter.

Ridgeway participates in the Safe Arrival Program through <u>School Messenger</u>. The Safe Arrival Program is an app that allows parents to quickly indicate that their child will be absent. Information about the app is attached.

We encourage you to use the app. If you encounter a challenge with the app, please phone 604-903-3740 to leave a message with your child's name, teacher, division number, and reason for absence.

What if my child is late?

Students arriving after 8:45 are asked to sign in outside of the main office. Students will take a blue Welcome Slip to class after signing in.

If your child arrives late and their class line up is already inside, please wait with your child while the other line ups enter then send your child into the main office. This courtesy supports the flow of traffic for our large student population and helps us ensure all students are accounted for in the building.

School Supplies

Fresh Air and Outside Play

At Ridgeway, our students go out at recess and lunch every day. Research clearly supports that children need regular breaks outside for fresh air and exercise. Please remember to dress your child appropriately for the weather. It will be a very rare occasion to stay inside during breaks, so please make sure to help set your child up for success in their day with necessary rain and outdoor gear. We encourage all students to have an extra set of clothing at school is helpful, especially for Primary students.



Personal Practices and Health Awareness

Schools can be supportive environments for communicable disease prevention by having staff model personal practices, sharing reliable information (e.g., BCCDC), promoting personal practices in the school, and ensuring individual choices for personal practices (e.g., wearing a mask) are supported and treated with respect.

Personal Practices:

- · check for symptoms of illness and stay home if sick (Health Awareness)
- wearing a mask or face covering is a personal choice
- practice hand hygiene often
- practice respiratory etiquette
- respect personal space
- avoid sharing items that come into contact with the mouth (e.g. food, drinks, utensils, etc)

Everyone entering the school (students, staff and visitors) should be aware of their responsibility to practice health awareness, including that they should not come to school if they are sick.

Medical Alerts and Allergies

If your child has any medical conditions that may need to be addressed at school (allergies, etc.), please contact the office as soon as possible. We will send home the required paperwork. Please ensure required medication, such as an EpiPen, is brought directly to the office.

We are a peanut and nut aware school. Please be mindful of the policy in your child's classroom as we have a number of students and staff with life threatening allergies to peanuts/nuts.

We are a scent free school. Please ensure your child does not use or bring scented products to school, including scented hand sanitizer.

Please make a plan to pick your child up promptly at dismissal time. Please note our early dismissal days and make arrangements for timely pick up on those days.


We will continue to share important dates weekly with Ridgeway's Week Ahead and will update these calendars as needed.
