Our Goal- To foster an environment that values deep student-centered learning and social-emotional well-being for all community members.

Areas to Celebrate:

Literacy (deep student-centered learning)

> Staff:

- o Full implementation of UFLI structured literacy approach
- o Purchase of UFLI teacher manual for all Primary teachers
- Purchased online RazKids licenses for decodable reading support
- Purchased additional online licenses for the Lexia program to support struggled readers
- Whole staff collaboration and professional development time focused on literacy
- Primary and Intermediate team engaged in professional learning to coassess student work and reflect on proficiency indicators

> Students:

- o All Primary students participated in ELA assessment
- Worked with students to plan a survey to be carried out in 2025-26 about literacy and reading to engage student voice

> Families:

 Shared information about structured literacy and science of reading at PAC meetings

Executive Functioning Skills (social-emotional wellbeing)

> Staff:

- Staff-wide staff-led professional learning about executive functioning skills and supports
- Sharing of staff developed executive functioning resources
- Full staff implementation of Ridgeway ROCKS PBIS Program
- EA training related to the Everyday Speech program and explicit teaching of executive functioning skills

> Students:

- Almost all students K-7 acknowledged for showing positive ROCKS behaviour
- School wide participation in explicit teaching of ROCKS expectations
- Developed ROCKS posters for an additional two student spaces (assembly, equipment sign out)



> Families:

- Provided parent/caregiver resources in Week Ahead newsletter and at PAC meetings
- Worked with PAC to support ROCKS prizes and shared rewards

Welcoming and inclusive environment (social-emotional wellbeing)

> Staff:

- Renewed start of year class profile meetings
- Staff led collaboration focused on inclusive and SOGI resources
- Regular community building opportunities at staff meetings

> Students:

- Over 150 students participated in student athletics
- Over 100 students participating in Intermediate Intramurals
- Over 50 students participated in student clubs
- Student led second annual Black Excellence Day assembly
- Student-led Pink Shirt Day assembly
- Student group supported school wide fundraiser and Walk for Wenjack

> Families:

- Hosted a new family tea with PAC
- Hosted annual Slice Night Open House with PAC
- o PAC hosted Ridgeway's annual multicultural fair
- o PAC sponsored a staff appreciated celebration

Areas for Growth:

- ➤ Refine literacy objective to reflect K-7 focus
 - o Work with Intermediate team to implement a shared reading assessment
- Add an objective about enhancing assessment practices
 - o Focus on increasing staff understanding of BC proficiency indicators
 - Continue to focus on clear communication with families through learning updates and conferences
- > Increase teacher and EA use of Everyday Speech for SEL support
- Work with PAC to host parent/caregiver executive functioning information night
- Continue to increase student and parent voice on the school planning team
 - 2 students per grade to participate in student group
 - Invite parents/caregivers to join at September 2025 meeting (open invitation for 4-5 parent representatives on School Planning Team)
