This week Ross Road will be recognizing both Indigenous Veterans Day (Nov 8) and Remembrance Day. Grade seven students have created a video presentation that each class will view during our 'assembly'. On the morning of Tuesday, November 10, 2020 we will hold a Remembrance Day 'Assembly' in our individual classrooms. On this day, students will receive a poppy to wear for this assembly and throughout the remainder of the day. We wear the poppy as a symbol to show that we pledge to remember those who sacrificed for our freedom. Throughout the week leading up to Remembrance Day, we will be collecting donations to the Poppy Fund. All donations to the Poppy Fund are placed in trust to be used for the care and support of Canada's Veterans and their families.
