Dear Ross Road Families,

We are looking forward to another week of learning and sharing together at Ross Road. We appreciate the diligence in which families are approaching the current health guidelines. Thank you for carefully doing a health check with your child each day and following the latest guidance. Students are remembering to bring a mask to school and are showing they can wear them correctly. Nice work! We continue to get questions about the current guidelines for self-monitoring and self-isolation. Please take time to read the links provided below to help inform any questions you may have.

Another way you can assist us is to ensure you are using SafeArrival or calling in absences and <u>providing a reason</u>. This allows us to more easily track absences for illness for example. In the case of absence due to illness, just knowing it is an illness is sufficient.

## **Important Health and Safety Reminders**

- Complete a <u>daily health check</u>
- Review personal hygiene strategies including frequent hand washing
- Review proper mask wearing with your child(ren)
- Ensure your child comes to school with spare, clean masks for use
- If unable to wear a mask due to an exemption, (as listed <u>HERE</u>, starting on page 20), please consider one of the alternatives shared <u>HERE</u>
- Utilize the space available and respect the personal space of others
- Dress for the weather and send a change of clothes
- Bring a refillable water bottle
